	0	The GP Anaesthetist is required to provide inpatient care for patients admitted into the Port Lincoln Health Services.
	0	Elective Anaesthetic Sessions approximately 4-8 per month
	0	The GP Anaesthetist also provides medical and anaesthetic services to the hospital and its emergency services as part of a roster with other GP's, GP Anaesthetists and GP Obstetricians
	0	The GP Anaesthetist is expected to participate in the Anaesthetic on call roster which is shared between four other Anaesthetists in the town and be on-call to A & E at the hospital for approximately 1x 24 hour shift per month on week day and approximately 1 x 12 hour shift per month on the weekend.
Teaching	0	The Investigator Clinic is a teaching practice for the Adelaide University Rural Clinical School
